Don't Give Up! Add Something Instead!

Every year Lent becomes like a mini Christian New year's resolution: What will you give up for this Lent? Over the years I have heard all sorts of things people have given up: Desserts, soda, coffee, chocolate, meat, TV, cigarettes, and eating out to name a few. This of course begs the question: Why DO Christians give something up during Lent?



The answer I have always heard is that we observe Lent as a somber expression of our faith as we see Jesus head towards the cross, His journey on our behalf that results in His death and subsequent resurrection. So for Lent, many Christians give something up, something that is hard to give up, as a small expression of sacrifice compared to the greater expression of sacrifice that is Jesus and His path to the cross. This is considered a bit of spiritual discipline, much like fasting or prayer.

I think it is beautiful that many Christians give something up for Lent. I however, do not give anything up for Lent! Instead, I add something! Now, I don't mean that I eat extra desserts or watch extra TV; but something to aid in my spiritual discipline. The last 5 years the "something" I have added is rather I add prayer with someone I don't know. Everyday during Lent, I sought out (and the Lord provided) a person or group of persons to pray with. That means sometimes I did the praying and at other times they did the praying! This year I am taking the "Love Dare" a fun 40 day program to strengthen my faith & marriage!

What about you? What is Lent about for you? Maybe you have never really done anything special for Lent; maybe you gave up on giving up! Why don't you join me this Lent and add a special something? Here are a few ideas if you need a little prodding:



You can add eating fruits and vegetables to your daily diet; you can add physical exercise everyday; you can add daily devotions, Bible reading & prayer; you can add complimenting people everyday; you can add helping a person each day; take "The Love Dare"; the list is endless!

Prayerfully consider what special and positive action you can add to your days during Lent. I firmly believe you can have an enriched Lenten experience and can grow in your spirituality by adding a simple gesture reflecting another side of what Jesus did on His journey to the cross: He loved and expressed compassion.

I pray that compassion and love washes over you like a great flood of warmth and care; so great is the love of our Father in the gift of His Son!

Bible study or Sunday School. We will do that once a month to help the two services get to know each other better!

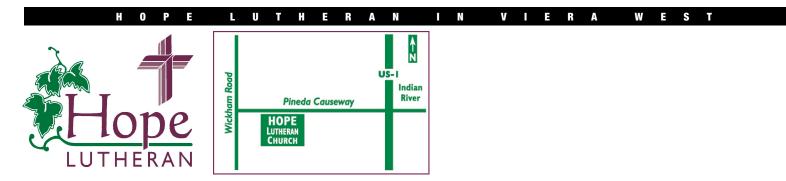
Daily Bread Work Day

25 Promises from the Bible for Financially Tough Days (from Purpose Driven Connection)

1. To care for you...

"And why worry about your clothes? Look at the lilies and how they grow. They don't work or make their clothing, yet Solomon in all his glory was not dressed as beautifully as they are. And if God cares so wonderfully for flowers that are here today and gone tomorrow, won't he more surely care for you?" (Matthew 6:28-30 NLT)

2. To provide for you...

"Don't ever worry and say, 'What are we going to eat?' or 'What are we going to drink?' or 'What are we going to wear?' Everyone is concerned about these things, and your heavenly Father certainly knows you need all of them. But first, be concerned about his kingdom and what has his approval. Then all these things will be provided for you" (Matthew 6:31-33 GW).

3. To help you deal with what happens that day...

"Give your entire attention to what God is doing right now, and don't get worked up about what may or may not happen tomorrow. God will help you deal with whatever hard things come up when the time comes" (Matthew 6:34 Msg).

4. To give you rest...

"Come to me, all of you who are tired and have heavy loads, and I will give you rest" (Matthew 11:28 NCV).

5. To lift you up...

"Humble yourselves, therefore, under God's mighty hand, that he may lift you up in due time. Cast all your anxiety on him because he cares for you" (1 Peter 5:6-7 NIV).

6. To give you peace...

"Don't fret or worry. Instead of worrying, pray. Let petitions and praises shape your worries into prayers, letting God know your concerns. Before you know it, a sense of God's wholeness, everything coming together for good, will come and settle you down. It's wonderful what happens when Christ displaces worry at the center of your life" (Philippians 4:6-7 Msg).

7. To give real treasure...

"Don't hoard treasure down here where it gets eaten by moths and corroded by rust or—worse!—stolen by burglars. Stockpile treasure in heaven, where it's safe from moth and rust and burglars. It's obvious, isn't it? The place where your treasure is, is the place you will most want to be, and end up being" (Matthew 6:19-21 Msg).

8. To grow your faith...

"Dear brothers and sisters, whenever trouble comes your way, let it be an opportunity for joy. For when your faith is tested, your endurance has a chance to grow. So let it grow, for when your endurance is fully developed, you will be strong in character and ready for anything" (James 1:2-4 NLT).

9. To give strength whatever the financial situation...

"I know how to live on almost nothing or with everything. I have learned the secret of living in every situation, whether it is with a full stomach or empty, with plenty or little. For I can do everything with the help of Christ who gives me the strength I need" (Philippians 4:12-13 NLT).

10. To meet all your needs...

"And my God will meet all your needs according to his glorious riches in Christ Jesus" (Philippians 4:19 NIV).

11. To protect you from fear...

"God is our refuge and strength, an ever-present help in trouble. Therefore we will not fear, though the earth give way and the mountains fall into the heart of the sea, though its waters roar and foam and the mountains quake with their surging" (Psalm 46:1-3 NIV).

12. To bless those who bless others...

"The one who blesses others is abundantly blessed; those who help others are helped" (Proverbs 11:25 Msg).

13. To work for the good...

"And we know that in all things God works for the good of those who love him, who have been called according to his purpose" (Romans 8:28 NIV).

14. To give you something to look forward to ...

"However, as it is written: 'No eye has seen, no ear has heard, no mind has conceived what God has prepared for those who love him" (I Corinthians 2:9 NIV).

15. To answer your prayers...

"Ask and it will be given to you; seek and you will find; knock and the door will be opened to you. For everyone who asks receives; he who seeks finds; and to him who knocks, the door will be opened" (Matthew 7:7-8 NIV).

16. To comfort you, and comfort others through you...

"Praise be to the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of compassion and the God of all comfort, who comforts us in all our troubles, so that we can comfort those in any trouble with the comfort we ourselves have received from God" (2 Corinthians 1:3-4 NIV).

17. To bring joy...

"Those who sow in tears will reap with songs of joy" (Psalm 126:5-6 NIV).

"Trust in the LORD with all your heart; do not depend on your own understanding. Seek his will in all you do, and he will direct your paths" (Proverbs 3:5-6 NLT).

23. To give you wisdom...

Q. What excuse did Adam give to his kids for no longer living in Eden? A. Your mother ate us out of house and home.

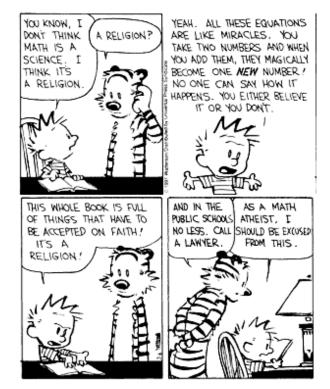
- Q. Which servant of God was the most flagrant lawbreaker?
